### **Open Afternoons for Parents**

As last summer, we would like to invite parents to come and visit their children in their classes, so that they can look through books together and explore the learning environment. The open afternoons will take place on <u>Monday 10<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup></u> <u>July from 1:20pm</u>. During the two afternoons, we will set up games and puzzles for the children to do and you will be invited to come in and see them in their classrooms. Due to space restrictions, we can only offer this opportunity to one parent unless there are very special circumstances, and we'll need to restrict numbers each day to 15 adults. There will be half of the class whose parents are not attending on the afternoon that you visit, so their class teacher will be engaging with those children, so they won't be in a position to do much more than welcome you into the classroom. If you would like to take your child with you when you leave, please make sure that you sign them out at the office, if it is before 3:15pm. You will be able to sign up one of the afternoons on E-Schools later this week – we'll send a message to let you know when this is available.
