Spelling Scheme

We wanted to update you with a change in one aspect of our English teaching. After Phonics Phase 6 in Y2, our pupils move onto a greater focus on spelling. We have been happy with our spelling programme and have achieved pleasing results in our statutory tests, but we feel we can do better. To this end, we have moved to a new programme called Ready Steady Spell. This programme emphasises spaced retrieval and embedded knowledge, so after a week of learning a spelling rule, the rule will be checked the following Friday. We're already really pleased with our pupils' response to this new style of spelling teaching and look forward to seeing the results.
